The National Transport Authority (the "NTA") has reviewed the above-referenced Strategic Infrastructure Development Application, and based on the Transport Strategy for the Greater Dublin Area 2022-2042 (the "Transport Strategy"), which is a consideration material to the proper planning and development of the Greater Dublin Area (GDA), submits the following observations.

Swords to City Centre Bus Connects Core Bus Corridor Project

A planning consent application was submitted by the NTA to An Bord Pleanála for the construction of the proposed Bus Connects Swords to City Centre Core Bus Corridor Scheme in May 2023. This application is currently being considered by the Board under case reg. ref. no. HA06D.317121.

Given that the proposed Greater Dublin Drainage Project (GDDP) would cross the proposed core bus corridor at the Collinstown Cross junction on the R132, the NTA welcomes the consideration given to the Core Bus Corridor Scheme as part of the submitted documentation.

On examination of this documentation, it is noted that the proposed timelines for the completion of the Core Bus Corridor Scheme and the GDDP could overlap and as such there is potential that their respective construction phases could coincide. Furthermore, from a review of the technical drawings submitted, it is also noted that elements of the GDDP, in particular Manhole 51 and the access road to compound number 5 have the potential to clash with elements of the works required for the Core Bus Corridor Scheme, if not coordinated effectively.

In this regard, it is requested that the applicant is conditioned to engage with the NTA as part of any grant of permission and that their detailed design and pre-construction stages are coordinated with that of the Core Bus Corridor Scheme design, to ensure that it does not prejudice the delivery of the Core Bus Corridor Scheme.

Metrolink Project

A railway order application was submitted by Transport Infrastructure Ireland in September 2022 to An Bord Pleanála for the construction of the proposed Metrolink project. This application is currently being considered by the Board under case reg. ref. no. NA29N.314724.

Having reviewed the proposed documentation submitted as part of the GDDP application, the NTA would request that the following documents are updated to accurately reflect the Metrolink scheme as per the application lodged:

- Appendix A4.2 Engineering Specialist Report for Crossings, Section 3.3.3 and Drawing 10 Appendix A4.2 Engineering Specialist Report for Crossings.pdf (pleanala.ie).
- Environmental Impact Assessment Report Volume 2 Part A of 6 Chapter 4 Description of the Proposed Project <u>Chapter 4 Description of the Proposed Project.pdf (pleanala.ie)</u> as updated in <u>Chapter 4A Description of the Proposed Project (pleanala.ie)</u> – The EIAR should be updated to reference the proposed MetroLink project.

Given there is potential for the construction phases of these two projects to overlap, it is important that the applicant considers the impact of such a scenario on working areas, wayleaves and rights of way. In this regard, it is requested that the applicant is conditioned to engage with the NTA and the TII Metrolink Project Team as part of any grant of permission and that their detailed design and preconstruction stages are coordinated with that of the Metrolink project to ensure that it does not prejudice the delivery of the Metrolink project.

I trust that the views of the NTA will be taken into consideration.
