I have received numerous representations from constituents in Dublin Bay North regarding the proposal by Irish Water to develop a Sewage Plant in Clonshaugh, at a site previously selected by Fingal County Council.

The main issues which have arisen concern:-

- Proximity to housing
- Smells
- Leaks
- Noise
- Impact on amenity
- Traffic
- The lack of local community gain from the project
- Impact of the outfall into Baldoyle Bay
- Risk of the impact of an accident or vandalism
- Pollution associated with emissions and discharges

It is vital that these concerns be addressed in the planning assessment and that the suitability of the proposal be robustly questioned. I am sure you will be engaging the necessary expertise to independently assess the evidence being put forward.
