Having received your correspondence attached I am appalled at your evasive high brow language regarding this matter and wish to reiterate what I have originally objected to and paid for same.


It is with the strongest of sentiment that I make this official objection to the building of the sewage plant reference no 06F.PC0152 in Clonsaugh ,Co.Dublin.

The scale of the centre is also deeply distressing not to mention the odours, traffic and blot on the landscape aesthetically.

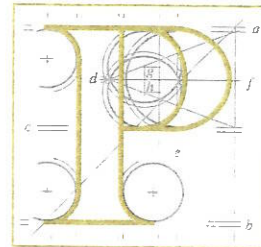
Please let it be noted that these are the grounds upon which I object and find attached the requested sum of fifty euro to do so.

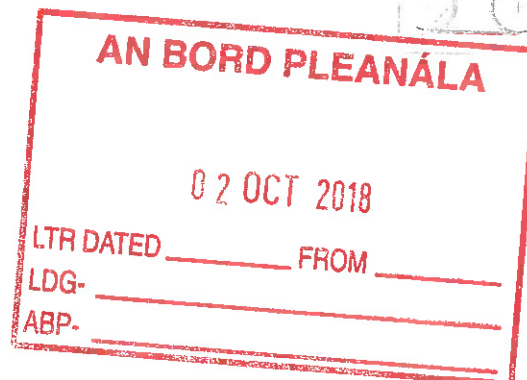

Dear Sir / Madam

I have been asked by An Bord Pleanála to refer further to the above-mentioned proposed development which is before the Board for consideration.

The Board in exercise of powers under section 37F of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, and having regard to the matter which was brought to its attention relating to appendices and other particulars which were inadvertently omitted by Irish Water from the EIAR which accompanied the planning application (as lodged on the 20th June, 2018), the Board is of the opinion that further public notice is required outlining the nature of these omissions and allowing a period of not less than 5 weeks for submissions/observations to be made. The public notice should include information relating to the locations where the documentation may be inspected (same locations as per the planning application).

The applicant is also required to again notify the same prescribed bodies (as per the original planning application) and ensure that a minimum period of not less than 5 weeks is allowed for the making of submissions/observations by the said bodies. New site notices should also be erected allowing the same time period for the making of submissions/observations. The notices should include a sentence that any person who has already paid the observer fee of €50 need not do so again in respect of a submission/observation.

Please ensure that the last date for receipt of submissions/observations to the Board is the same for all such notices and letters to prescribed bodies and, additionally, the Commission for Railway Regulation and Irish Rail (which have separately been notified by the Board). Having reviewed the application documentation, the Board is also of the view that the Irish Aviation Authority should be notified of the planning application by Irish Water and requested to furnish any submissions it might have to the Board.
