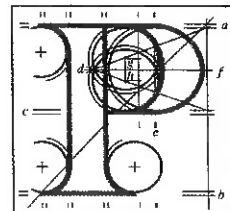



I, Siobhan O'Brien, wish to put in an objection to the proposed gigantic Waste Water Treatment Plant at Clonsaugh to the Greater Dublin Drainage Project Manager.

My concerns:-

1. The plant is so near to where many people live. Houses/ Apartments are being built at present near the proposed lands in Clonsaugh. The land is suitable for homes not a gigantic water treatment plant, if built, will destroy our home living conditions. We will not have clean air, a basic human right. Will we be able to go out our gardens and enjoy without smelling sewage?
2. There were three sites and on reading, it seems that Clonsaugh was the most cost effective, being the nearest in close proximity to Baldoyle estuary. It seems that money saving is more important than people's lives and quality of life in Clonsaugh and surrounding homes.
3. With the size of the plant, there will be a huge odour of sewage at certain times of day/night when the vents are opened to let the 'gasses' out. This will have detrimental effect on the air we breathe, as well as the stench outside our doors every day. This has to be a terrible mistake to think that Irish Water can build a monster plant in a built up area in Dublin. Thousands of residents will be affected. I am an asthmatic and I have concerns that the polluted air will exacerbate my condition in a negative way. Environmental agencies have conducted research, but as there are no other treatment plants of this size in Ireland, they really cannot ascertain what the impact will be. What about people/children who have chest problems?

4. As well as the vents, there will be the holding sludge tanks which emit a constant foul smell. Anyone who wants a sample of what the stench is like; take a stroll down the south wall near the treatment plant. It is not for the faint hearted.
5. The sheer size of the proposed plant will ensure our homes will be undesirable to live in as no one will buy a home so close to a treatment plant of that magnitude. Our homes will be worthless.
6. Grade 2 treated sewage will pollute our sea , Our beautiful beaches in Baldoyle, Portmarnock and Malahide will be negatively affected in terms of our natural amenities. The sheer size would ensure that the plant would pump grade 2 sewage constantly just beyond Ireland's Eye.
7. Fish will be polluted, as it is impossible to pump the level of sewage (even grade 2 treated) and not have a negative impact on our seas. Swimmers and fishing will be affected. The outpipe will be 2 metres wide, and in constant use. The volume of sewage cannot be supported by one area alone .Howth, Malahide, Baldoyle and Portmarnock areas will be destroyed.
8. It is impossible not to have sewage plants in Ireland and am aware that they are part of the great Dublin drainage and sewage plan , but my concerns are that big solutions to our problems Ireland do not work, if you take Ballymun high rise flats , as answer to housing that did not work. I feel that this will be the same. I am concerned that this will be an environmental disaster especially as the company (Veolia) that have got the tender , do not have a great record with sewage plants .
9. I strongly advocate that the plant is downsized in to smaller more manageable plants, situated away from residential homes.
10. Another issue is that most people did /do not know about the proposed plant. I wonder why it was not more in the public domain? I have also sent in a signed petition of nearly 500 names of people who are concerned and request an oral hearing.


