- Local businesses will suffer as nobody wants to visit a place that smells of excrement.
- All of our children will be still expected to play outside during government decided breaks in schoolyards that stink and air that is unhealthy ie. similar to the situation in Ringsend.
- We will be unable to open our windows because of flies and bluebottles that will inevitably
 infect us with germs, thus the quality of air inside our homes will be impacted.
