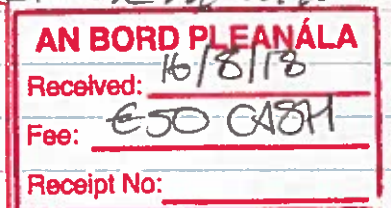
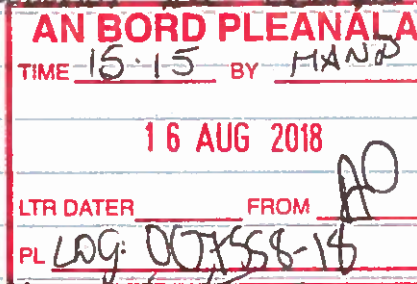

ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES

The ENVIRONMENT of Clonsillaugh / Swifts Grove / Newbury / Priorswood / Mountview / Beckamp / Derrindale will be greatly effected, because of their close proximity to the Proposed Site, ie 300mtrs. The impact on 2,500 HOMES in this immediate area will cause health issues because of the Plants size, noise, traffic, smell landscape, airborne particles, and all other issues that can occur in a plant this size in a highly populated Residential Area.

Portlarnock outfall pipeline.

Is 6km to the outfall of waste water Far enough out to sea to stop pollution of the Area. Portlarnock the only Blue Flag Beach in the North City Region. Baldoyle, Howth, Malahide are also the subject of Prevailing winds and tides.
