
The Board will revert to you in due course with regard to the matter.

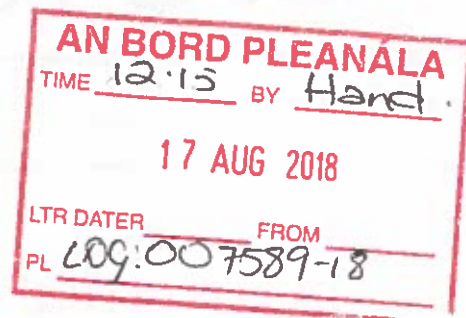
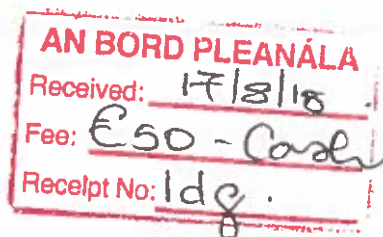
