

1 We the residents of Swifts Grove No's agree totally that this site is unsuitable for this area as it is too close to highly populated areas which are expanding year on year.

2 We feel very concerned with the amount of noise arising from the construction of the Treatment Plant and also if the plant gets up and running.

3 We have major concern regarding the odour from said Plant, as we all remember the problems the residents of Ringsend had with the Plant situated there. We know regardless of Odour suppression measures being put in place it is inevitable there will be odour problems.

Our roads are at full capacity to date and are at a standstill for most of the working day so with the amount of traffic coming and going from this site to the R139, M50 and M1 it will hugely impact on local residents. With high density housing being built on the North Fringe the roads will be at breaking point.

We are opposed to any large scale water Treatment Plants on this site.
