

I note from the Public and Stakeholder Participation Report there was only one meeting held with the Clonshaugh residents and this was in the initial phase on the 19<sup>th</sup> November 2014. There have been no further meetings and we would be a major stakeholder as the plant will be positioned only 300 meters to the nearest house. The proposed site for this plant is much too close to the residential area, schools, hotels and other local amenities.

Also in the Public and Stakeholder Participation Report it notes a public information evening was held on 29<sup>th</sup> November in Northern Cross for Clonshaugh residents, yet no local people seem to know anything about this. Where was the notification posted for this? How many people attended this session? Are the recorded minutes? The proposed plant will be 300 meters from nearest house. The size of the plant is 13,200 square meters, how can this be deemed best practice?

## Objection to sewerage system in clonshaugh

To whom it may concern,

We wish to object to the sewage system that is proposed to be built in the clonshaugh area.

The reason for this is we are a large population of Traveller's families living in this area.

(220) Families with approx. 450 individuals. Which live in the area of

- Cara Park
- Cara Close
- Northern Close
- Units Cara Park
- Tara lawns
- Grove Lane
- Belcamp Lane
- Newtown Court
- Dominic's Park
- Moyne Park
- Traveller families in private houses

We have a lot of serious health issues among our families some of them being autism, metabolic conditions, respiratory conditions heart disease and cancer.

We already have a shorter life expectancy than the general population due to our poor living conditions and by this sewage system being put in place this is going to have a detrimental effect on the health of our families.

- Life Expectancy and Mortality 3.1 Life Expectancy | the life expectancy at birth for Traveller women is now years, which is 11.5 years less than women in the general population, and is equivalent to the life expectancy of the general population in the 1960's.
- The infant mortality rate for Travellers is 3.6 times the rate of the general population (4 infant deaths per 1,000 live births in the general population compared to 14 infant deaths per 1,000 live births in the Traveller population)

We are sending this in as a joint objection to this sewage system as some of the individuals who are objecting to it have either no literacy or very poor literacy skills so some of us are taking the lead on it.
