

With reference to the proposed project the Commission for Railway Regulation (CRR) makes the following observations for your consideration for the project;

1. Notification of your decision is required to the railway undertaking, namely Iarnród Éireann.
2. Iarnród Éireann should be consulted to ensure that risks associated with railway trespass are not increased near the project, either during the works or when the works are complete.
3. The party undertaking the construction should ensure future works which may affect the safe operation of the railway are undertaken with the consultation of Iarnród Éireann and in accordance with CRR Guideline CRR-G-010-A (Third Party Guidance on Railway Risk Volume 1 Planning and Development – available on the CRR website).
4. Observations or issues raised by Iarnród Éireann should be addressed.
5. If permission is granted, the party undertaking the work should consult with Iarnród Éireann regarding road-rail interfaces on access routes which may have increased flow or abnormal loads during the construction phase and upon completion of the project.
