Uisce Éireann notes the contents of the letter and confirm that they will implement the stated requirements, in accordance with sub-section 2(b) of 37F of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as follows:

- (i) Publish in one or more newspapers a notice stating that significant additional information in relation to the said effects has been furnished to the Board, that the additional information will be available, for inspection or for purchase, at a specified place and at specified times during a specified period, and that submissions or observations in relation to the additional information may be made in writing to the Board before a specified date;
- (ii) Update the stand alone project website stating that the additional information can be downloaded; and
- (iii) Send notice of the furnishing to the Board of significant additional information and a copy of the additional information, to the planning authorities and to the prescribed bodies stating that submissions or observations in relation to the additional information may be made in writing to the Board before a specified date.

Uisce Éireann confirm that the notices will be published in the same newspapers in which notices of the original application were advertised and the additional information will be made available for inspection or purchase at the same locations at which the original application documentation was available.
