

Community Consultation

There has been a total lack of Community Consultation, we were 1st made aware of the Wind Farm plans in 2019 yet the developer had silently been working since 2017 ~~not~~ signing up land-owners without the wider community

being made aware of any such plans.

When the residents decided to organise a meeting to discuss the developers intervened and got the meeting cancelled due to the location of the meeting, how is this Community involvement, They have also avoided meeting people when delivering their news letters avoiding face to face contact by either as dropping the news letters and leaving as fast as they can as seen by myself, they have also gotten another body to deliver other letters just as not to engage with people.

The information in the maps in these news letters are not constant, changing with every 1, study area enlarging and wind test masts in different places

Shadow Plicher

No Shadow Plicher study has been undertaken that conforms to the best practice

It also has the effect of a light being turned on and off

Flora and Fauna

There is an abundance of wildlife in the area that will be directly affected by this development

Many of which are on the Red list

Water Well Source

It was pointed out to the developer that our water source which is a springy well is a shallow water vein running below the surface close to ~~Toombang~~ Turbine 6, we also have an outside well which we use to water cattle on the land, yet after making this aware to them there has been no contact from the developer as in a survey or water testing or any contact, if this development interferes with our water supply who is to be held responsible as it is a EU Right to water

We also have had experience of a sub-contractor from the surveyor illegally entering our property for water samples, when approached he said he
