As a resident of Dundrum, I wish to see the appropriate development of the Old Dundrum Shopping Centre site to provide appropriate development of housing and community facilities. The current proposals seem to be out of scale with the area and lack the inclusion civic and commercial provision and social space that would provide human sized development. I make the following observations.

- The current plan is of unremitting high-rise blocks, which will be in total contrast to current configuration of the area. While some multi-storey development may be appropriate, the sixteen-storey tower is excessive. The height of residential development needs to be reduced. Eight to twelve storeys are very high.
- There should be social space where people can meet and interact. To have a park area <u>behind</u> the current church away from the Main Street is an invitation to antisocial behaviour. It would be far better to have social space along the Main Street.
- Conservation concerns demand that current houses along Main Street should be retained and adapted as necessary, but not simply demolished.
- The proposed five storey building along Main Street makes the street less humanfriendly. As already suggested there needs to be space for meeting and social interaction.
- The current proposal suggests a new population of 3000 people on the site. If anything like this is to happen there must be adequate provision of shops and entertainment facilities. Perhaps the proposed population density is too great for the area. The current plan is for 95% residential development.

The residential units should include three bedroomed apartments suitable for families as well as one and two bedded apartments. Care must be taken to avoid control of the entire residential development by investment of the entire residential development by who are to live in the proposed new residential development should own their own homes or rent from a range of small landlords.
