Re Strategic Housing Development Application by Gavin Home Properties Ltd at "Barrington Gates" and "Winterbrook" Brennanstown Rd D.18 (APB Ref 313281)

Dear Sir/Madam

Brennanstown Rd is a narrow winding road with no footpath in part and sub-standard footpath in other parts. Can have problems to pass each other, lorries have problem and are unable to pass without mounting the footpath (where there is a footpath).

The development which is under construction by Park Development has a new roundabout which large lorries, especially construction lorries have to use the wrong way round and mount the kerbs even some signage has been removed.

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown C.C. made a decision that no more major development should take place on Brennanstown Rd until the road was "Sorted". Since then at least 2 have got permission.

Access to Babbinteeley by foot + cycle are most dangerous as there is no footpath in part, the safest way would be through Babbinteeley Park which is locked at night which is about 4.30 pm in winter.

When a house "Appleton" went on fire about a year ago the Fire Engine had to close the road and their Water Tankers which were required had great problem getting to the fire due to a build up of traffic and the width of the road.

The removal of good healthy trees to the north of the site is not in anybody's interest.

The combined density and height of various blocks of apartment containing 534 units are overbearing and will cause shadowing to both the apartments themselves, the open areas about the blocks and also to the existing properties close to the site
