My observations are as follows:

- The building of these structures will have a hugely negative impact on the setting of local heritage sites ie Barrington Towers (a protected structure) & the Brennanstown Dolmen which is a 5,500-year-old National Monument.
- 10 storey buildings are inappropriate structures to be so close to a National Monument.
- Are there any views of the valley from these buildings? It is highly unlikely.
- The light, noise & disturbance to the Glendruid Valley Woodlands would be detrimental to wildlife.
- As a resident who has lived in the area for over 30 years it has become very clear that we are losing all our green areas.
- It is beginning to feel like living in a concrete jungle.
- This will have a huge impact on future generations
- The infrastructure is inadequate for cars, bicycles & pedestrians.
- This is not urban planning but developers squeezing as much as they can into a small area.
