- 3. The planning application was valid.
- 4. Pre-application consultations in accordance with section 5 of the Act of 2016 were held with under reference ABP-307784-20 ABP's Opinion was that the documents submitted requires further consideration and amendment to constitute a reasonable basis for an application for strategic housing development.
