This is a high priority case.

On 16th May, 2022, the Board received a 3rd Party appeal from An Taisce against Fingal County Council's planning register reference number FW21A/0151, decision to grant permission, subject to 23 conditions, for the demolition of 2 existing residential buildings and the construction of 2 data hall buildings at lands adjacent to Huntstown Power Station, North Road, Finglas, Dublin 11.

The appeal was circulated to the planning authority and the applicant (Huntsown Power Company Limited) on 17th May, 2022.

On the 17th May, 2022, the Board received a further 3rd party appeal from John Conway and Louth Environmental Group. This appeal was cross circulated on 19th May, 2022.

The planning authority and the applicant responded within the statutory timeframe. I deem it necessary to circulate the applicant's response under section 131 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended (Task-289381-22). I do not consider it necessary to circulate the planning authority's response to the appeals.

Three observations were received within the statutory timeframe. These observations were from Roísín Shorthall, Fingal One Future and Proinsias Mac Fhlannchadha. I do not consider it necessary to circulate any of these observations.
