I wish to object to the rezoning of the Santry Avenue SHD application (Case ref No:TA29N.314019) for the following reasons:

1. Current building density is being increased in the area with a lack of related physical infrastructure - cycle paths, footpaths, roads, schools and creches.

While this is a 'Strategic' Hosuing development there appears to be litle stratgey about devleoping the local community to go with it. This is the main reason for my objection.

I have no difficulty with increased housing but there has to be infrastructure to support the increased population in the area.

- 2. There is no plan for the provision of the required social infrastructure community centre, scout hall, youth club, all weather sports facility, library etc.
- 3. The lack of employment opportunities in the area continues, as businesses are closed down in favour of residential development. This undermines the 15 min city concept promoted by the Council.
- 4. There appears to be no consideration of the impact on vehicular traffic in Santry that the increased population will inevitably have.
- 7. We need a Local Area Plan to integrate social and physical infrastructure with appropriate residential amd commercial developments.
- 8. I am in favour of mixed and diverse housing solutions that form part of a self-sustaining community and support a 15 minute city.
