## **Re: KRCRA Submission DART West + Railway Order Ref No 314232**

To whom it may concern

We are writing to you on behalf of the Kirkpatrick Rockfield Coolmine residents association (KRCRA).

We are based immediately north of the Coolmine Level Crossing and yet again would like to say we welcome the electrification of the Maynooth Line. We wish to make the following comments regarding Irish Rail's response to our submission.

### **Point 1**

In our submission we disputed the assumptions made and consequently the need to close the level crossings. We have always welcomed the electrification and upgrading of the line but cannot understand the need to permanently close the level crossings.

We questioned the passenger number figures on the basis that previous predictions by Irish Rail on passenger numbers appear to be grossly inaccurate. Consequently, we requested that an independent body carry out a more realistic assessment. We referred to a Railway

Order granted in 2008 which stated "*It is intended to run a total 44 trains between Clonsilla and Pace increasing to 88 trains over subsequent years leading to a peak service of one train every 15 minutes. Total passenger demands are predicted from rail feasibility studies to be in the region of 2 million passenger trips by 2016* (ABP Inspectors Report p.7) (Appendix 1). We pointed out that currently, 15 years post the granting of this order, trains run every 30 mins peak hour and hourly outside peak hours which is a huge difference to what was predicted.

Irish Rail's response to our request for an independent body to carry out a realistic assessment was to refer us to sections 2.2.8 and 2.2.15. In these sections they stated:

1. The increase in passenger demand is one reason but not the only one.
2. Expansion of heavy rail network has been a key long-term objective of CIE and others
3. The National Development Plan 2021-2030 considers the DART + programme to be the corner stone of rail investment
4. "*At an international level the DART + programme supports Ireland's commitment to fulfil its obligation as an EU member state regarding greenhouse gas emission reduction targets*" etc.
5. The improved frequency and quality of service will provide a viable transport alternative for existing and future communities
6. "*the project is fundamental to supporting the economic and social growth that has been highlighted by the National Planning Framework and County Development Plans*".
7. Increasing the capacity of the network is the primary objective of DART + West
8. "*The project aims to cope with a maximum capacity of 12 trains per hour per direction and this has been the basis of the model detailing the train movements during the peak hours*".
9. "*A correct analysis of passenger demand trends requires observation over long periods of time*".
10. "*The 12 trains per hour per direction used as the basis for the project will be implemented using a phased rollout and depending on demand figures, represent the peak hour target number for design and environmental impact analysis. During off peak hours, the timetable will be adjusted based on different aspects, rail census being one of them.*"

None of the information provided has dealt with our concerns. Points 1 to 8 appear to simply reiterate the reasons for the electrification of the line which we don't have an issue with. Point 9 is just a statement. Point 10 is simply reiterating the 12 trains per hour per direction mantra.

In addition, at this hearing (5<sup>th</sup> October) a discussion took place which made the 12 trains per hour per direction (phpd) even more confusing. It appears that the 12 trains phpd are

based on the City Centre i.e through Drumcondra. Of the 12 trains, we were informed that 2 will be Sligo. We would like to know how many of the remaining 10 will be going to Hazelhatch. According to the current timetable (Appendix 2), there are 2 trains through Drumcondara to Hazelhatch during the peak hours (8am – 9am, 5pm -6pm and 6pm – 7pm). Is there a plan to increase the number of trains serving Hazelhatch at any stage over the next 15 years? If yes, this would appear to reduce the number of trains going through Coolmine.

On the 5<sup>th</sup> October Irish Rail also mentioned they had a 15-year horizon when looking at projects. Therefore, in addition to our initial request for a realistic assessment of passenger numbers we would like to know

- Why did Irish Rail get it so wrong in 2008?
- Has your analysis of passenger demand trends altered since then?
- Can you tell me what changes you have made?
- Based on your 15 year horizon can you please tell us how many trains you predict will be going through Coolmine in years 1, 3 , 5, 10 and 15?

Given the failure to provide the information we requested we continue to believe that the level crossings should not be permanently close. It is important to ensure that the extensive disruption which will be caused by the level crossing closures will not occur unless the closures are justified using accurate & realistic figures.

## Point 2

We also questioned the need to close the level crossings given the fact that the current DART service operates successfully on the Southside of Dublin. If we assume the service will emulate the current DART service (every 10 mins between 6.50am and 8pm and every 15 to 20 minutes outside of that), this would amount to 196 trains per day. Currently there are 210 scheduled services through Merrion Gate and all level crossings between Pearse & Bray. These level crossings operate successfully and do not appear to cause major problems to traffic or the DART service. Irish Rail should have to explain why the level crossings on the Maynooth line need to close when there is no need to do so elsewhere. Simply saying “we will be closing the level crossings elsewhere too” is not an explanation. As mentioned already, the level crossing closures will be very disruptive to many communities so they should only be closed when there is clear and detailed information, for everyone to see, that closure is essential not simply desirable.

The response to this was:

- The removal of the level crossing will improve train efficiencies, will enhance safety, and will remove the delays caused by the road-rail interface. Their closure will also remove the periodic blockages on the road system, which are currently very pronounced, especially in the morning and evening peak commuter periods

- In order to achieve the project objectives of significantly higher train frequencies it is not viable to retain the level crossings.
- The design team has examined the feasibility of meeting the project objectives while keeping the level crossings in place and it has concluded that the project objectives cannot be delivered on this basis.

In relation to the comment regarding the closure removing the periodic blockage on the road system, In our opinion the proposals do not remove blockages from the area but simply relocate the blockages to Dr Troy Bridge and Castleknock Road.

Given that the proposed system on the Maynooth Line will not generate any more trains than that which operates on the Southside we cannot understand and Irish Rail have not answered the question.

In relation to the feasibility study they have not explained how the system can be operated on the southside but not the northside.

Once again, we do not believe Irish Rail have correctly responded to our comments. We still believe the level crossing should not be permanently closed. There is no reason why the proposed pedestrian/cycle bridge, with lifts, cannot be built without permanently closing the level crossing. Such a move would facilitate more evidence based assessment of the required closure times. In addition having the new cycle/footbridge will improve safety regardless of whether the level crossings remain closed or not.

### **Point 3**

We raised concerns over the “*subject to passenger demand*” comment in the Non-Technical report summary (p.49). There are promises of huge increases in the number of trains and claims this can only be done if the level crossings close but for some unknown reason Irish Rail feel the need to put in a get out clause. We asked what service they will be providing if the passenger demand is not as they predicted after all keeping the level crossings open until they have a better idea of the demand appears to be a more sensible option.

Irish Rail’s response was “*the increase in train frequency and capacity proposes as part of the scheme is to meet passenger the future passenger demand which is anticipated to increase form 5000 in 2019 to 13 300 passengers in 2025*”.

We would also like to point out that firstly, we dispute the figure quoted for 2019 and secondly question the figure estimated for 2025. The National Rail Census Report 2022 demonstrates a figure of 3455 for Boarding/alighting at Coolmine (Appendix 3)and the total figures for all stations is much higher than the 5000 quoted. Where does this figure come from? In relation to the 2025 figure we fail to understand how it will have increased so much when the Dart West Project won’t even be completed.

Once again, our questions have not been answered and therefore the level crossings should be left open.

#### **Point 4**

We expressed our disappointment that there wasn't a standardisation of the pedestrian/cycle bridges at all the stations but all Irish Rail did was confirm that concrete bridges were their preference. They failed to explain why they were using 2 different types of material. Under the Railway Order the bridges at Ashtown and Coolmine had been designed using CORTEN steel while the bridges at Porterstown and Clonsilla are concrete. This is extremely disappointing. However, we note the new proposal, submitted by Irish Rail on the first day of the oral hearing and consider the standardisation of bridges is preferable using CORTEN steel for all. We ask the board to accept the new option for bridges.

#### **Point 5**

We expressed our disappointment that there were no lifts being provided at Coolmine.. It should be a condition of any approval that lifts are provided in tandem with a 24-hour maintenance contract to ensure prompt repairs to facilitate the mobility impaired who cannot use the bridges or steps.

Irish Rail's response in the Railway Order was that it was technically feasible to include them but they didn't include them! This is not a reasonable response to our request. Again, we note that lifts have been included in the new option provided by Irish Rail and welcome their inclusion. We request the Inspector includes this as a condition of the Railway Order together with the provision of a 24/7 maintenance contract for all lifts along the line.

#### **Point 6**

We raised concerns related to safety and Anti-Social Behaviour in the station and surrounding areas and requested that a condition of the granting of the Railway Order be for Irish Rail to liaise and meet with An Garda Siochana to discuss current best practice in terms of crime prevention with regard to lighting, access and extending the use of CCTV to all stations in the development and surrounding areas. Whilst Irish Rail have confirmed that as far as practicable the measures requested will be included we are anxious about some of their responses

Firstly they state that "*anti-social behaviour or safety concerns are subjective and therefore it is not possible to use a standard based assessment approach*"

We wish to remind them that on the 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2022 Minister for Justice, Helen McEntee stated "*Community safety is a much broader concept than crime or fear of crime. It is about people being safe and feeling safe in their communities. It can include the responsiveness of emergency services, mental health issues, education, drug abuse prevention, alcohol and substance abuse, domestic violence, youth crime, anti-social behaviour (our bold), hate crime and the built environment (our bold). This is reflected in the key principle in the programme for Government, Our Shared Future, to build stronger and safer communities. The well-being of communities is among our highest priorities and we want members of the public to feel confident and secure in going about their lives*" (<https://www.oireachtas.ie/en/debates/debate/dail/2020-11-18/22/> accessed 24/10/2022)

We want the well-being of the community to be a very high priority for Irish Rail in the construction and operation of the Dart West Project.

Secondly, Irish Rail mentioned the potential psychosocial effects during the construction phase. We don't understand what this means in relation to the building of bridges and would like it clarified for residents.

## Point 7

We raised concerns about problems with car parking caused by commuters parking their cars to use the train. Indeed, Irish Rail refer to it in the Public Consultation 2 Findings Report. In it they state "*respondents raised concerns regarding increased demand for parking due to the severance from the car park and more commuters using the estates in the vicinity to park their cars for free*". We believe it is imperative that a condition be included that Irish Rail & Fingal in conjunction with residents draw up an agreed parking management plan before any level crossings are closed.

The response from IE was "*The IE project team has consulted extensively and agreed the proposed design with the LA. Illegal parking outside of the IE property is the responsibility of the LA and An Garda Siochana*".

This response is worrying. It is Irish Rail's project that will potentially cause huge problems for residents not only in our association but neighbouring areas too. We question the comment regarding "*agreed the proposed design with the LA*"


At a Development Plan meeting in Fingal County Council on the 18<sup>th</sup> October 2022 (Motion A1081801 6.26.31 [https://fingalcoco.public-i.tv/core/portal/webcast\\_interactive/712409](https://fingalcoco.public-i.tv/core/portal/webcast_interactive/712409)) when discussing a motion proposed by a local councillor to ensure pedestrian, cyclist and vehicular connectivity across the canal be included in the development plan Fingal County Council state that "*in our last consultation phase with Irish Rail (IR) we put in a submission to them which captures a lot of what has just been said here. We (FCC) would have similar concerns about the removal of one of the key crossings in that area, there isn't a huge number of crossings to begin with so there is going to be impacts. We (FCC) would also have concerns about that in what it means for the proposals to enlarge a number of junctions around that area resulting in increased traffic flows, increased noise congestion, air quality issues on the diversionary routes. What it means at a slightly higher level is we need to work much harder to ensure the active travel options are much more attractive, much more accessible, and that we insulate the bus service from those problems that are going to be created, there is congestion at the moment and if we take out a key link there it's very likely that there is going to be even more congestion*". He goes on to talk about the hierarchy of users. He also says:

***"We will work through all that with Irish Rail through the railway order process and will be at the oral hearing and we will be represented there to tease all that out with them". (Our bold)***

It is incredibly disappointing that Irish Rail have dismissed the issue given that it is their project that could cause problems and that Fingal County Council appear to have failed in their stated objective.

We thank the board for the opportunity to raise these issues and reiterate our request that the level crossing at Coolmine remains open. We do not object to pedestrian/cycle bridges, with lifts, but believe that permanently closing the level crossings at this point in time is unnecessary and disruptive.

## **APPENDIX 3**

## **1.4. Proposed Development.**

1.4.1. The principal elements of the proposed development consist of

- The construction of approximately 7.5km of dual track from Pace to Clonsilla along an existing discontinued alignment for series 2900 Diesel Multiple trains with plans to electrify the railway line in the future. This is seen as the first phase in the reopening of the Navan line. The line would connect to the existing main line from Connolly Station to Sligo at Clonsilla.
- It is intended to run a total of 44 trains between Clonsilla and Pace increasing to 88 trains over subsequent years leading to a peak service of one train every 15 minutes. Total passenger demands are predicted from rail feasibility studies to be in the region of 2 million passenger trips by 2016.
- The construction of new railway stations at Pace and Dunboyne. The stations are to a generic design and will consist of 174m long platforms, buildings and footbridges. The style of the stations follows an IE Architectural theme already established along the Maynooth line.
- Construction of platforms at Hansfield Station site (Hansfield station will be constructed in the future as the area is developed).
- The provision of park and ride facilities for 1200 cars located south of the M3 interchange at Pace.
- The provision of car parking spaces for 420 cars at Dunboyne station on the east side of the rail.
- The construction of three accommodation bridges at Hilltown, Dunboyne and Hansfield.
- The demolition of bridges at Bennetstown and farmer's Accommodation Bridge north of Stirling Bridge.
- Strengthening works to the existing bridges at Barnhill, Sterling and Dunboyne.
- The construction of a new railway bridge across the Royal Canal west of Clonsilla.
- The construction of a new foot/cycle bridge immediately north of Dunboyne Bridge.
- The replacement/construction/strengthening of three river-under-rail bridges, one for crossing the Tolka north of Dunboyne, one south of Dunboyne for the Castle Stream water-course, and a third for the Tolka at Bracetown.
- Associated infrastructure, earthworks, drainage, culverts etc.
- The installation of new boundary treatment works along the rail corridor – to be one of four types.
- Public lighting for roads, stations and car parks.

1.4.2. Given that all of the property required to construct and operate the railway is in private ownership, the lands to be acquired constitute only those areas necessary to construct stations and car parks, maintain minimum lateral clearances, embankments/cuttings and longitudinal drainage ditches.

1.4.3. The overall construction period is expected to take 24 months commencing in 2008. It is proposed to locate five construction compounds along the railway. Four of these take access from existing roads. The fifth, the Pace Park and Ride site, will take access from the new Dunboyne by-pass and M3 Interchange that
