










View from Gheel Autism facing East towards

Dart West area proposing to locate flood compensatory storage ponds here in a flood plain that is subject to considerable flooding already. See Picture 10





Proposed Location of New Rail line and Embankment shown in red. Picture taken from Jacksons Bridge East towards Maynooth. Dart West area proposing to locate flood compensatory storage ponds here in a flood plain that is subject to considerable flooding already. The proposed train line and embankment will significantly affect the current flow of water and considerable reduce the flood plain and contribute to considerable additional flooding. A clear view of the Dart West Proposed Rail line and embankment through flood plain taken August 2023. (Red Line). Significant Flooding issue have not been addressed by DART West and flood relief ponds are to be location exactly at this location in a flood plain that is subject to significant flooding and therefore will not provide any additional flood capacity. (see photo from Jacksons bridge). Infact, hydrology calculation have been significantly qualified by Dart West Engineers in so far as they won't accept responsibility for unforeseen events. Is Flooding in August an unforeseen event? Please note there will be considerable additional water introduced to the watercourse as part introduced to the watercourse as part of this proposed development.

Proposed Dart West line and Relief ponds located in existing flood plain at Jacksons Bridge and L5041. There will be no significant additional flood relief storage provided yet, considerable additional water introduced to existing watercourses and considerable flooding.






Figure 6-1 Proposed Compensatory Storage Area - Jacksons Bridge
