

## DART+ West Electrified Railway Order 2022 - SID Ref 314232

Dear Sir/Madam.

Dublin City Council received letters dated 8th and 15th November 2023 from Geraldine Finucane, Secretary to the Board of Córas Iompair Éireann (CIE), stating that additional information regarding the potential environmental impacts had been provided to An Bord Pleanála for the proposed railway work associated with the DART+ West Railway Order. Dublin City Council is a prescribed body for this Railway Order application and has been granted the opportunity to comment on the material received by 7th December 2023.

The supplementary information submitted to An Bord Pleanála is documented in the report titled "Update to the Natura Impact Statement," dated October 2023, available on the following website: www.dartwestrailwayorder.ie. This update primarily addresses the inclusion of the candidate Special Protection Area North-west Irish Sea cSPA 4236, which was inadvertently omitted from the "Natura Impact Statement" report dated July 2022.

The updated material adopts a comprehensive approach, supplementing the information previously presented in the "Natura Impact Statement" report dated July 2022. The primary focus is on the potential entry of pollutants into Dublin Bay during the construction phase and their impact on marine bird species associated with the cSPA.

In this context, the implementation of mitigation measures outlined in the "Natura Impact Statement" report dated July 2022, in conjunction with construction management plan measures, is deemed appropriate.

I trust that the above information will be duly considered in the due course of proceedings.
