 Please find hereunder an application for permission for the above-mentioned proposed development. A fee of €79,900.40 has been submitted with the application. Two printed copies and three electronic copies of the application documentation have been received in accordance with article 297(5) of the Planning and Development (Strategic Housing Development) Regulations 2017.

- 3. The planning application was valid.
- 4. OPINION FURTHER CONSIDERATION: Pre-application consultations in accordance with section 5 of the Act of 2016 were held with under reference ABP-312202-21. ABP's Opinion was that the documents submitted requires further consideration and amendment to constitute a reasonable basis for an application for strategic housing development.
- 5. The planning application contains documents submitted in accordance with the Planning and Development (Housing) and Residential Tenancies Act 2016.
- 6. A EIAR has been submitted with this application.
- 7. The Appropriate Assessment Screening Report concludes that on the basis of objective information, the proposed development, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, is not likely to have significant effects on any European sites.

- 8. The Material Contravention Statement can be permitted under the provisions of the Planning and Development (Housing) and Residential Tenancies Act 2016.
- 9. A submission was received from Irish Water on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2022 which states that the Applicant has engaged with Irish Water in respect of design proposal for which they have been issued a Statement of Design Acceptance for the development.
- 10. The public notice was published in the Irish Daily Mail newspaper dated 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022. The site notice was erected on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2022.
