1	Key Submission Points	2	The primary reason of this observation is to make Metro North and other relevant bodies, aware of our presence and the geographical position of our (20ft) storage container, which appears to be within the intended work space of the Metro North build. We have a 20ft storage container positioned directly alongside (and to the west of) Cabra for Youth's 40ft storage container. It seems likely in order for the Metro North works to commence at Glasnevin, that our 20ft container will have to be moved. We have no major objections to a move on a temporary basis, however we would need the container to be relocated close to Cross Guns Bridge and within a few meters of the canal, in order to continue our good work.	As indicated by Figure 5.1. of EIAR Chapter 5, MetroLink Construction Phase, the storage container is indeed located within the identified construction compound associated with Glasnevin Station. The container will have to be temporarily moved during the works and will be relocated back as close as possible to its original location in consultation with the Royal Clean Up Group.
