**Re:** Railway (Metrolink - Estuary to Charlemont via Dublin Airport) Order [2022]  
Estuary through Swords, Dublin Airport, Ballymun, Glasnevin and City Centre to Charlemont, Co. Dublin

Dear Sir / Madam,

I have been asked by An Bord Pleanála to refer further to the above-mentioned proposed development which is before the Board for consideration.

The Board in exercise of powers under section 41 of the Transport (Railway Infrastructure) Act, 2001, as amended, and having regard to the matter which was brought to its attention relating to Appendix A9-2-M Traffic and Transportation Assessment - St. Stephens's Green Station which was inadvertently omitted by Transport Infrastructure Ireland from the EIAR which accompanied the application (as lodged on the 30th September, 2022) the Board is of the opinion that further public notice is required outlining the nature of the omission and allowing a period of not less than 6 weeks for submissions/observations to be made. The public notice should include information relating to the locations where the documentation may be inspected (same locations as per the application).

The applicant is also required to again notify the same landowners and prescribed bodies (as per the original application) and ensure that a minimum period of not less than 6 weeks is allowed for the making of submissions/observations by the said bodies. The notices should include a sentence that any person who has already paid the observer fee of €50 need not do so again in respect of a submission/observation.

Please ensure that the last date for receipt of submissions/observations to the Board is the same for all such notices and letters to landowners and prescribed bodies.

**Please note that in accordance with section 251 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, (as amended), the period beginning on 24th December and ending on 1st January, both dates inclusive, should be disregarded for the purposes of calculating the last date for lodgement of submissions or observations**


