Re: Railway (Metrolink - Estuary to Charlemont via Dublin Airport) Order [2022]

Dear Sir / Madam,

I refer to the documents submitted by Transport Infrastructure Ireland to the Board during the oral hearing into this case and to the further information received by the Board on 12th June 2024 in relation to the above-mentioned railway order application.

In accordance with section 47D(1)(b) of the Transport (Railway Infrastructure) Act 2001, as amended, the Board has decided to make all of this additional information relating to the application available for inspection and to invite further submissions or observation to be made to it in relation to it.

In this regard the Board is now requesting you to do the following:

- (a) Make all of this information available by placing an identical copy of the oral hearing documentation and the further information as submitted to the Board by on the dedicated website for this application. This documentation should be clearly identified on the website and be downloadable.
- (b) Publish in one or more newspapers circulating in the area to which the order relates a notice stating that the oral hearing documents and the further information will be available, for inspection or for purchase (upon payment of a specified fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy), at a specified place and at specified times during a specified period, that submissions or observations in relation to the information may be made in writing to the Board before a specified date (which shall not be less than **6 weeks**).
- (c) Send copies of the documents lodged at the oral hearing and the further information to any planning authority in whose functional area (or any part thereof) the proposed railway works are proposed to be carried out and also to any designated bodies served with copies of the original application documentation and advising them that submissions or observations on the additional information may be made to the Board in writing before a specified date (which shall be not less than **6 weeks**).

In respect of (b) above the notices should be published in the same newspapers in which notices of the original application was advertised and the additional information should be made available for inspection or purchase at the same locations at which the original application documentation was available.

You should submit copies of the relevant newspaper notices and notices to designated bodies to the Board as soon as same are available.

An Bord Pleanála will also be directly alerting the relevant planning authorities, designated bodies and persons who have already made submissions or observations to it on the application, of this decision and process.

Your response to this letter should be received not later than 5.30 p.m. on 22nd July 2024.
