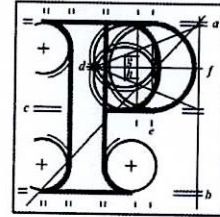

This document is an observation on behalf of Glasnevin Village Residents Association in respect of the MetroLink Railway Order.

Our comments are:

- While construction is ongoing, care will need to be taken to minimise the effects on residents of the Village. We expect the contractors to adhere to normal guidelines re construction in urban areas.
- In our view, the station at Albert College Park should be called National Botanic Gardens, to reflect the proximity of the station to one of the Dublin City's premier attractions.
