

I wish to lodge my objection to the Metrolink North Project running under my house at 111, Botanic Rd. Glasnevin. Dublin 9.on the following grounds.

- 1. My house is over 100 years old and was built with little or no foundations as were the other houses on my terrace. Concrete was not readily available at the time of building these houses
- 2. The depth of the escavations in my opinion is not nearly deep enough and this may cause subsidence and de stabilize the house.
- 3. Why was this particular terrace of houses chosen when much newer houses with proper foundations further up on next terrace were not chosen?
- 3. The fact that this is presented to us with no choice in the matter is very upsetting.
- 4. I have a Bus stop outside my house for over forty years. The house rattles every time buses stop outside it. I can only imagine what further vibrations may do to it.
- 5. All sorts of promises are been make that surveys of properties will take place and that ground in these areas will be accessed before construction. So far I've had no contact from anyone on this matter.
- 6. The fact that the historical value of the area is been ignored especially in the construction of the Glasnevin station is another worrying aspect of this Project.
