

Dear Aisling,

I am writing to you today to voice of our concerns regarding the proposed development of a circular economy campus and an integrated waste management facility at the Hollywood landfill.

We object to this proposal for the following reasons:

- 1) There is a water aquifer under the location which provides water to surrounding areas (Ring commons, Balbriggan etc). If this water becomes contaminated due to the proposed development it will have serious consequences for drinking water and also horticultural sector.
- 2) There is already a number of large trucks using the road to access Hollywood landfill. Due to the large volume of traffic daily it is causing the road to deteriorate. We live on a S bend which has now become very unsafe for pedestrians and cyclists due to the speed of these large trucks.
3. Hedgestown national school is on the route where trucks will be passing by. This is a concern for childrens safety as there will be traffic at school drop off/collection times. It will be unsafe for children to walk/cycle to school due to the large volume of trucks.

Please take the above reasons into consideration when reviewing this proposal.
