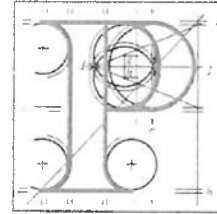

We wish to acknowledge your letter of 21st May 2024.

Further to our letter dated 21st April and having read the correspondence from RPS Consulting Engineers Ltd. - it is our understanding that at no point was permission given for the intake of hazardous waste.

In fact on page 8 it states -

Objective IUO30 relates to hazardous waste which is not relevant to the proposed development.

We absolutely object to the proposed intake of hazardous waste onto this site at Hollywood Great, which could put the groundwater aquifer at risk of contamination.

Also, there is a new Primary School at the junction of The Five Roads and the movement of trucks in excess of 200 approx. per day puts children, parents and locals at unacceptable risk.

Please take our objections into serious consideration.
