

## Observation of strategic infrastructure development application Case ref. no. ABP314964

## Dear Sir or Madam,

We wish to object to the planned development at Hollywood, Great Nag's Head, Naul, Co. Dublin.

We represent the Board of Directors of Country Crest Ltd. & Ballymaguire Foods Ltd, Rathmooney, Lusk, Co. Dublin

The site is located only 5km to the East of the subject site

Ballymaguire Foods & Country Crest employ over 400 people at their site in the Agri-Business & Food Supply sector.

The Ballymaguire Foods and Country Crest rely solely on well extraction for water supply- they simply cannot risk any pollution to this water supply

The grounds for our objection are as follows;

1. There is a high risk of contamination of ground water aquifer under the subject site which is the source of well water extraction at Country Crest. The Proposed site and the site of Ballymaguire Foods / Country Crest are on the same geological formation, same aquifer, and same groundwater body which is called Lusk-Bog of the Ring Groundwater Body.



Lusk Bog of the Ring Aquifer

- 2. The site was previously found to be unsuitable by the EPA EPA license application W0129-03.
- 3. Planning Ref. F19/0077 relating to earlier works on the site states the site does not authorise recycling activities.
- 4. The risk of leachate from the process on site and the fact the site is located at the highest point in North County Dublin is an added risk factor.
- 5. There is no natural bunding on site these works would be better suited to a site with an impervious clay substrate and not the fractured porous rock with no natural protection to leachate.

We ask that An Bord Pleanála refuse this permission and suggest a low lying site on an impervious soil would be a better location.
