To whom it may concern,

I would like to submit an objection to case ref ABP 314964.

The submission by IMS has serious consequences for the surrounding local environment.

The application has proposed to landfill Toxic and Hazardous Incinerator Bottom Ash. The company looking for permission for a total of 25 years.

A condition in F19/0077 States the following this permission does not authorise recycling activities.

This incinerator bottom ash will leak into the underlying water resource and waterways, and is deeply concerning for residents, farmers, and local businesses.

The EPA has already refused a licence for landfilling on this site for this reason, (EPA Licence ref WO129-03.

the surrounding area is primarily an agricultural area, contaminating water puts local Produce and Animal welfare at risk.

The trucks carrying hazardous waste to and from the site are a serious concern currently as they travel at great speeds on rural roads. There is a new school being built at the five roads which will increase the danger to children, parents and staff. If this submission goes through will inevitably increase the volume of trucks on the road.
