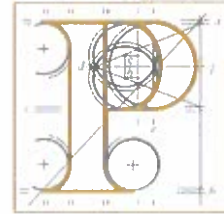

An Bord Pleanála has asked me to refer to the above-mentioned pre-application consultation request.

The Board notes that it is two years since the last meeting and that the last correspondence was received from you on 9th April 2024. Given the length of time that has now elapsed, the Board has formed the opinion that the request to enter into pre-application consultations is no longer being actively pursued.

The Board intends to deem the consultations as closed if it does not receive correspondence from you stating the reasons why you consider that the consultations should remain open. Please be advised that it is open to you to withdraw the request or confirm that the consultations are closed.

In the event that the Board regards the case as closed or that you withdraw the request, the file will be made available for public inspection in accordance with the Board's normal procedures.

Should you at some stage in the future wish to proceed with the project following the closure of consultations or the withdrawal of the request, it will be necessary for you to make a new pre-application consultation request to the Board. In that case a new file will be opened to allow the process to proceed. Any response to this letter should be received by the Board on or before **12th May 2025**. If no response is received to this letter the Board will proceed to close the pre-application consultation.
