The Board hereby serves notice under section 37J(3) of the 2000 Act, as amended, that it appears to the Board that it would not be possible to determine the above matter within the period of 18 weeks (i.e. by the 11th September 2023) because further consideration of the case is required.

The Board intends to determine the application for permission of the above proposed development before the 11th January 2024. The Board will take all such steps as are open to it to ensure that the matter is determined before that date.
