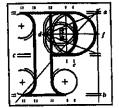

## DART+South West Electrified Heavy Railway Order [2023].

I wish to **object** to the above planning application on the points listed below.

The proposed reconstruction of the bridge, ref. (OBC5) at the Khyber Pass and associated works will impact on my property from a **privacy** point of view. The steps leading to the bridge are currently screened from my property by a line of mature trees at the end of my garden. The proposal to rebuild the bridge with increased height and wider span, and to compulsorily acquire a 24.2 square metres strip of my garden, which is where the trees are growing, for the purpose of widening the Kyhber Pass and making a Haul Route for other related works, will require the removal to the trees resulting in the complete loss of privacy.

There is an area of unused ground (ref. 18832 T 302 B) currently wild and overgrown, within the Seven Oaks apartment complex which could by used if the footbridge was re-aligned at a skew.

Alternatively one of C.I.É's own proposals was to remove the footbridge completely and staff use another route going to and from the C.I.É. Works, which they will have to do anyway while the work is in progress.

The proposed widening of the Khyber Pass laneway will involve the removal of the boundary wall and the acquisition of part of my property by Compulsory Purchase Order. The removal of this wall will impact on my property from a **security** aspect as it will expose my property and neighbouring properties to potential intruders and trespassers during the demolition and construction stages of the project.

The temporary acquisition of a further 75.2 sq.m. of my property as a construction site for the Khyber Pass footbridge and a as haul route for other works related to the DART + South West project will require the removal of the trees which currently provide a privacy and security screen not only from people using the footbridge but also from the Seven Oaks apartment complex. These trees took a long time to grow as will any replacements.

Based on the above I trust that my concerns will be taken into consideration prior to a decision being reached on this planning application.

As my property is directly impacted by this planning proposal I am not enclosing the 50 euro fee.
