

In terms of my review of the works to be carried out, my main causes of concerns are as follows:

- 1. Nosie, access and transport disruption during period of works (ref environmental impact report)
- 2. Ongoing noise and disruption as a result of increased frequency of trains, once works are completed
- 3. Loss of access to/ and or ownership of commonly owned land as a result of any potentional compulsory purchase order (temporary or permanent)

To mitigate against the above concerns my is request is for:

- 1. Replacement of external doors and windows for my apartment
- 2. Advance notification of any works that will take place during the night (something that has been gravely lacking up to this point)
- 3. Adequate sound proofing measures to be implemented as part of all works completed
- Market aligned compensation to home owners for any land that is compulsory purcahsed (either temporary or permanent)

Given that the outlined works will provide absolutely no benefit to the Sarsfiueld road community that will experience significant disruption both during the works and indefinitely thereafetr, the above requests are more than reasonable in my view. I look forward to your response.
