

## Dear Board

I represent the estate of Mr Paul O'Brien late of 65 Kylemore Drive which is a property that may be affected by the granting of the DART + South West Electrified Heavy Railway Order (2023). It is my understanding that II do not need to pay a fee to make this observation and can sent it via email. However if that is not the case I will gladly pay the relevant fee.

I wish to lodge an objection to the granting of the order on the basis that it severely impacts on my ability to realise the assets of Mr O'Brien either by selling the property ,or renting it out, based on the severe disruption that will ensue during the duration of the works and the limitations on the possible extension to the property following the completion of the project. Having taken advice on the matter I have been advised that properties with compulsory orders attached are extremely difficult to sell. If I cannot dispose of the property it could also become liable for vacant property tax. Taking everything into account this is an excessively harsh and disproportionate impact on the beneficiaries of the estate and I ask that the application be refused.
