Memorandum ABP-316178-23 – Request for Further Information

Re: Proposed development of Oweninny Windfarm Phase 3 consisting of 18 no. wind turbines within the townlands of Laghtanvack, Croaghaun (also known as Croaghaun West), Moneynieran, Corvoderry, Shanvolahan, Dooleg More, Shranakilly, Bellacorrick and Shanvodinnaun, Co. Mayo.

My previous Memo dated 3rd October relates. The applicant was requested to provide both the ITM and Eircode for each of the 78 shadow flicker receptors with an annotated map indicating each of the receptors.

A series of aerial photographs were submitted by the applicant detailing the location and number of each sensitive receptor, its associated Eircode and ITM co-ordinates.

It is now apparent that the Noise Sensitive Receptors, identified as R1-R80 and set out in Appendix 13.1 detailing the ITM coordinates correspond to the ITM co-ordinates of the shadow flicker sensitive receptors, with the exception of R65 and R66 (not used).

The Shadow Flicker Study concluded that subject to mitigation no properties have the potential to experience cumulative shadow flicker impacts. The aerial maps do not alter this conclusion; but do allow for the data to be interpreted accurately.

I have reviewed the information submitted and am satisfied that while I do not consider the information submitted is significant (i.e. does not warrant readvertisement), I am of the opinion that the additional information should be circulated to all parties for comment. Please allow three weeks for comment.
