In accordance with section 37J(2)(a) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, it is a statutory objective of the Board to ensure that a decision under section 37G on an application made under section 37E is made within a period of 18 weeks beginning on the last date for making observations or submissions.

Where it appears to the Board that it would not be possible or appropriate to determine a particular application for permission within this period, a notice must be sent to the applicant, planning authority and any person who made submissions / observations in relation to the matter in accordance with section 37J(3) of the 2000 Act as amended.

The Board hereby serves notice under section 37J(3) of the 2000 Act, as amended, that it appears to the Board that it would not be possible to determine the above matter within the period of 18 weeks (5th December 2023) because further consideration of the case is required.

The Board intends to determine the application for permission of the above proposed development before the 5th March 2024. The Board will take all such steps as are open to it to ensure that the matter is determined before that date.
