This Site is unsuitable for a development of this Scale and Nature. I have Walked this mountain since I was very young. All you need to do is walk upon the Soil underneath your feet and you will know with certainty No matter how much Concrete is piled upon it, it Can not Sustain Such structures.

As you are aware it is also one of the most Scenic areas natural, Unspoilt in all of West Waterford. It is Wrong to Ever Contemplate introducing Even one pylon not to mention the Magnitude that is being suggested.

As a Registered General Nurse myself I would also Question What type of an effect it will have on the Mental and physical health of the people who are living simply Kilometers away from the proposed Site.

This Windfarm is not Wanted
in Mount Mellera Co. Waterford
