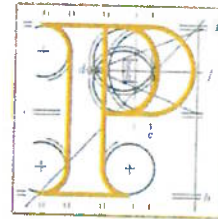

Dear Sir / Madam,

I refer to the additional information received by the Board in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the above-mentioned proposed development. Please be advised that the Board considers that this additional information contains significant additional data in relation to the effects on the environment of the proposed development and it therefore requires you in accordance with section 2(b) of 37F of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, to:

(a) publish in one or more newspapers circulating in the area in which the proposed development would take place a notice stating that significant additional information in relation to the said effects has been furnished to the Board, that the additional information will be available, for inspection or for purchase (upon payment of a specified fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy), at a specified place and at specified times during a specified period, and that submissions or observations in relation to the additional information may be made in writing to the Board before a specified date (which shall not be less than 30 days), and update the stand-alone website stating that the additional information can be downloaded, and

(b) send notice of the furnishing to the Board of significant additional information and a copy of the additional information, to the planning authority and to the prescribed bodies stating that submissions or observations in relation to the additional information may be made in writing to the Board before a specified date (which shall not be less than 30 days).

In respect of (a) above the notices should be published in the same newspapers in which notices of the original application was advertised and the additional information should be made available for inspection or purchase at the same locations at which the original application documentation was available. The Board would also request that site notices be erected in this regard.

You should submit the relevant newspaper notices and a copy of any site notices issued under (b) above to the Board as soon as same are available.


