Dear Grace,

Thank you for your submission at the Oral Hearing for the Firlough Wind Farm and Hydrogen Plant.

Your home is located on the construction haul route away from the Wind Farm.

There will be increased traffic along this route during the construction phase only. Construction is expected to take 21 months.

The average will be 15 trucks per day during the construction period.

During the construction phase there will be 13 days (not all in a row) where the turbine foundations will have their concrete poured. This will require a much higher number of trucks to deliver the concrete. During these 13 days there will be approximately 140 trucks per day.

These dates will be known in advance and the community, including you, will be notified.

There will be a Traffic Management Plan for the project – this will organise and manage the deliveries needed for the construction of the Project.

This will be kept updated and agreed with both Silgo and Mayo county councils.

We will provide a permanently attended dedicated telephone number to you for use in the event of a medical emergency.



If you require emergency medical assistance you may contact us on this dedicated telephone number and we will suspend all deliveries to or from the proposed development to ensure priority access for any medical personnel.
