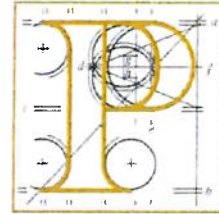

I, Oliver Carney, own a plot of bog with turbary rights in Kilbride Bog (Carrowleagh).  
I have not been contacted by anyone about the proposed development to put windmills/  
turbines on this bog nor have I authorised anyone to take my plot of turf. I purchased this  
bank of turf in good faith and have been harvesting turf on it for almost three decades.  
I have no intention of giving anyone permission to use my plot of bog which is included in  
the footprint of the wind farm, located directly under a turbine.

- On Kilbride Bog 'Fee simple' only comes into play on each plot that is 100% cut away. Fully cut away plots then fall under Fee simple
- Turbary Rights Remain on each plot where there is still uncut peat & this includes the cutaway portion of each plot in turbary rights.
- Fee simple rights go to Commonage owners
