

Board Direction BD-014659-23 ABP-318302-23

This remitted application was considered at a Board meeting held on the 23/11/2023. The Board noted the terms of the High Court Orders perfected on the 29th June 2023 and the 6th July 2023.

The Board decided that the following steps be taken in relation to the remitted application:

- 1. An Taisce's submission dated the 4th February 2022 shall be acknowledged and forwarded to the planning authority for information.
- 2. The Applicant shall be invited to make a submission on An Taisce's submission.
- 3. The Applicant to be informed of the quash and remit of the case and given the passage of time invited to make any further submission they wish to make on the application, including any updates to the EIAR and AA screening Report/NIS in accordance with S37F(1) of the PDA. (Allow 4 weeks). Copies of the High Court Orders to be enclosed.
- 4. All other participants in the application shall be notified of the High Court Order remitting this case back to the Board for a fresh determination. Copies of the High Court Orders to be enclosed and the participants informed that they will be given an opportunity to comment on any updates that the Applicant may submit on the application.

Upon completion of the above process, the file to be referred back to the Board with any responses to the said notices, for further consideration of the case, including to assess the need for new public notices and the allocation to a new inspector to carry out a de novo assessment of the application.
