

Dear Secretary,

The Authority acknowledges receipt of referral of the above proposed Strategic Infrastructure Development Application. In the assessment of the subject application, TII recommends consideration of the following;

National Strategic Outcome 2 of the National Planning Framework includes the objective to maintain the strategic capacity and safety of the national roads network. In addition, Chapter 7 'Enhanced Regional Accessibility' of the National Development Plan, 2021 – 2030, sets out the key sectoral priority of maintaining Ireland's existing national road network to a robust and safe standard for users. This requirement is further reflected in the publication of the National Investment Framework for Transport in Ireland and also the existing Statutory Section 28 Spatial Planning and National Roads Guidelines for Planning Authorities.

The Authority notes the subject development site accesses the local road network prior to accessing the N69, national road, and notes the traffic analysis undertaken in support of the subject application outlined in Section 14 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR).

Having regard to the extent of the operations presented in the EIAR and the location of the subject site accessing the local road network, the Authority has no specific comment to make in relation to the subject development in terms of impacts relating to the safe and efficient operation of the national road network in the area.

The Authority has no other specific comments to make in relation to the proposed development and trusts that the foregoing proves of assistance to the Board in dealing with this matter.
