I found this especially during the stress and uncertainties of covid times. The peace and tranquillity of our unspoilt Comeraghs bring solace to many.
- 2) The biodiversity and habitats of the Comeragh Uplands is of the utmost importance. So IMPORTANT that SUBSTANTIAL funding has been allocated for the uplands known as the Comeragh Communities EIP Project The project is funded by the EU Recovery Instrument Funding under the Rural Development programme. One of the visions for the Coumnagappul Upland is to improve and maintain the quality of the habitat. How can you improve and maintain the quality of the habitats by allowing your upland farm to be part of an Industrial sized windfarm?

The comments by another participant in the group who is NOT involved in the proposed Wind Farm and from a different Upland of the Comeraghs really struck a chord with the local community he stated "The sessions with the ecologist were the
