AMENDED REFERRAL RESPONSE

Uisce Éireann's amended response to proposed Strategic Infrastructure Development of a 10turbine wind energy development by Coumnagappul Wind Farm Ltd. within the townlands of Bleantasourmountain, Carrigbrack, Clooncogaile, Coumnagappul, Glennaneanemountain, Kilkeany, Kilkeany Mountain, Knocavanniamountain and Reanadampaun Commons, Ballymacmague North, Ballymacmague South, Colligan More, Colliganwood, Eaglehill, Garryclone, Garryduff, Kilcooney, Killadangan, Knockacaharna, Knockboy, Lackandarra Upper and Tinalira Co. Waterford.

Dear Sir/ Madam,

Uisce Éireann (UÉ) previously issued a response to the above application dated 12 January 2024. Please disregard the previous response.

Having reviewed the plans and particulars submitted for this application and have the following observations:

There are number of UÉ watermains and pipes along the proposed 22.47km underground cabling route which will be impacted by the proposed development. Acknowledging that UÉ was consulted at EIAR scoping stage, the applicant has not engaged with UÉ regarding the proposed underground cabling that is proposed under, over and in close proximity to the existing Uisce Éireann infrastructure. No plans or

details showing the number or locations of the overlap with UE infrastructure has been

submitted.

The proposed 110kv underground cable is significant infrastructure and any interaction

with public watermains and/or infrastructure needs to be carefully considered in order

to ensure the public assets are adequately protected.

Structures or works over or in close proximity to <u>U</u>É infrastructure that may inhibit access for

maintenance or endanger structural or functional integrity of the infrastructure are not permitted and

separation distances shall be in accordance with the UÉ Codes of Practice and Standard Details.

UÉ have no objection in principle with building under UÉ infrastructure provided the

assets are protected during the construction & operation phases of the development

and that adequate separation distances are provided. However, UÉ cannot support

proposals to cross above UÉ assets without sufficient, clear and detailed information.

Where building near / building over / diversions of existing UÉ assets are proposed,

the associated designs need to be agreed with the UÉ Diversions team, a

Confirmation of Feasibility must be issued by in the first instance UÉ before planning

permission is granted.

In the context of above, UE requests that the applicant is required to submit a

Confirmation of Feasibility to the UÉ Diversions team in order to asses the interactions

with public water infrastructure. The Confirmation of Feasibility should be submitted to

An Bord Pleanála as a response to this further information request.
