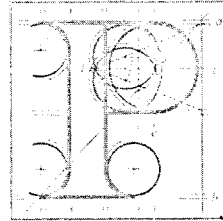

To whom it concerns —

In relation to An Coimisiún Pleanála case reference PA04.318802 (“Proposed development of a resource recovery centre (including waste-to-energy facility)”), as elected members of Cork City Council, we wish to make the following observations:

- Cork Harbour is a shared and unifying resource between Cork City Council and Cork County Council, — the economic, environmental and social protection and proper management of which is in our common and mutual interests and of the people we represent.
- There is no boundary between Cork City Council and Cork County Council’s functional areas with respect to air pollution, — developments allowed within the county area that negatively impact air quality and the health of residents there have the potential to equally negatively impact air quality and the health of residents in the city area, and vice versa.
