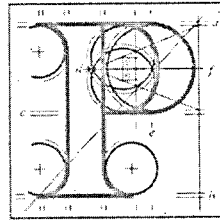

Dear Sir/Madam,

I would like to submit my observation regarding planning application No APB 318802-24, Indaver waste facility in Cork harbour.

I previously submitted an observation. To note my postal address has changed to the following: Neptune House, Graball Bay, Crosshaven, Co Cork P43XK25.

For 24 years approximately Indaver have been trying to get planning permission to build an unwanted facility in Cork Harbour.

We have a clean, widely used harbour, for both pleasure and tourism and is a fishing harbour for commercial fishermen.

The proposed incinerator has no place within. Public health air quality would be affected by the constant plume, which would take in a wide radius from the site. Thousands of people/homes, work place, schools and colleges will all be impacted. This in turn will have a severe impact on our climate goals.

The visual impact and environmental damage to Cork Harbour would be irreversible, should it be granted permission. Cork Harbour is quite distinctive, and easily recognised by Roches Point lighthouse, St Coleman's Cathedral Cobh, Camden Fort Meaghar Crosshaven, to name a few iconic areas . To put an incinerator amongst these areas, in the second largest natural harbour in the world just does not make sense.

Ireland has improved Recycling etc, and welcomes renewable energy. An incinerator is certainly not the way forward, it would be quite the opposite in fact.

I'm respectfully asking An Coimisiun Pleanala, not to grant permission.
