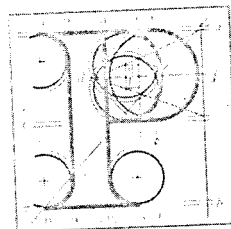

Dear Sir/Madam

My name is Jackelina Pando Kelly. I live in Myrtleville Cork

I am submitting this letter to object the plan for having an Incinerator in Cork .

My reasons for objections are:

Public health risk due to the following:

- This will create significant air pollution affecting our health (due to the high risk of lung cancer and other chronic respiratory conditions)
- This will create significant water pollution that will affect the quality of the water in our ocean (for swimming , but also affecting the ocean life – fish and others that are consumed by humans)
- Risk to local workers
- Breaches the WHO Guidelines
- It is not recommended to build incinerators in areas that are subject to 'thermal inversion' and Cork Harbour is subject to this as a result of the basin-like topography of the area.

Negative environment impact :

- This is a health risk not only to humans but to other living beings in the ocean, in the air (birds) and nearby natural areas.
- I believe that there hasn't been a proper and accurate environmental assessment


Not aligned with the future of Cork Harbour :

- Removing access to public beaches
- Conflicts with county development and tourism
- The area has been zoned for education and research (not for this kind of industry)
- Cork Harbour is a world class tourism destination, and this will be affected with an incinerator so nearby touristic areas .

It is my understanding that few years ago , a High Court decided to refuse planning for this project. That decision should be respected, as the negative impact that the incinerator will have has not changed at all

Will appreciate if you consider this objection for the benefit of our own people in Cork , and for the future of our environment in which our children and their children will live
