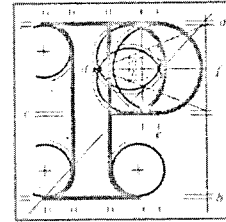

Dear Sir/Madam,

I refer to the above planning application and I wish to make the following objection in relation to the proposed development.

1. This proposed incinerator will be in operation 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The air pollution and fall-out caused by this operation will increase the likelihood of adult and childhood cancers along with other adverse medical difficulties. The burning of this toxic and hazardous waste would be detrimental to my family, local community and other communities within many miles radius of this plant.
2. The waste ash containing carcinogenic waste materials will be transported on the M28 roadway passing within 50 metres of my house daily with the high possibility of this dust escaping while on transport.
3. The pollutant emissions from the proposed 50 metre high stack will have a domineering effect on my home visually and aesthetically.
4. Ringaskiddy is a beautiful residential village with two wonderful beaches, Haulbowline Park, the pier at Paddy's Point with beautiful views of the Cork harbour. This proposed incinerator would be grossly incompatible.
5. The people of Ringaskiddy, Cork harbour and beyond have repeatedly and clearly stated No to this incinerator over many years. Our community has carried the burden of defending this legacy proposal long enough. What we need now are projects that protect public health, support green jobs and enhance Cork harbour.
6. There is a plan of integrating the aesthetics of Cork harbour with existing industries and Port activities, most definitely not this abomination.
